

MANZANITA, OR

WHY IT'S COZY Heated floors, private outdoor hot tubs, feather beds, and barbecues that double as firepits. WHAT'S OUT THE DOOR The cutest small town on the Oregon Coast (for more, see page 58), a windswept beach, and killer sunsets. Cinematic Cannon Beach is 13 miles north. WHO WILL LOVE IT Anyone who's tired of sky-high-priced hotels on the California Coast. 6 cabins from \$215; coastcabins.com.

COPALIS BEACH, WA

WHY IT'S COZY It's been renovated to add woodstoves and Adirondack chairs on the back porch, plus homey touches in the rooms, like jigsaw puzzles and board games. WHAT'S OUT THE DOOR Woodsy hiking trails, the 364-acre Griffiths-Priday Ocean State Park, shorebirds, and ready-to-harvest razor clams. Olympic National Park is 25 miles to the northeast. WHO WILL LOVE IT Families with young kids. 25 one- and two-bedroom cabins from \$279; ironspringsresort.com.

The Lodge at Suttle Lake

SISTERS, OR

WHY IT'S COZY Rustic knotty pine meets wrought-iron chandelier, 35 miles northwest of Bend. Stone fireplaces, private decks, wooden rocking chairs. WHAT'S OUT THE DOOR The namesake 1½-milelong lake, plus lounging in the on-site spa. WHO WILL LOVE IT Friends on a getaway. 6 rustic cabins (sleep 6) with shared bathrooms from \$69, 4 luxury waterfront cabins (sleep 4) from \$367; thelodgeatsuttle lake.com.
